We are so excited to welcome you back to the Children's School. A lot of people all around us got sick, so we closed for a while to make sure everyone stayed safe.

Now that people are getting better, we get to come back to school. It's still the same place you remember, but it is going to look a little different. We want to make sure everyone stays safe and healthy at school and at home.

Before you come to school, you and the grown up who brings you will put on masks. This is to keep you, your friends, and your teachers safe.

When your grown up drops you off in the morning, you will do a few things before you come inside. First, you will come to the sign-in table. The sign-in table will be in the parking lot. You will rinse your hands with hand sanitizer. Remember to do tops and bottoms.

Next, your grown up will sign you in. One of your teachers will take your temperature. You won't need to open your mouth. We use a thermometer that doesn't even touch you.

When your hands are clean, you get to decide where you want to play in the house. The tables won't have as many chairs. We need to sit a little farther apart to make sure no one gets sick.





After you are done playing with something, you will put it in the cleaning tub. Then a teacher will clean it before someone else plays with it. This will help keep everyone safe and healthy.

At snack time, you will wash your hands before you eat.



Everyone will bring their own snack from home. You get to decide what to bring! This will help all of our friends stay healthy. If you stay for lunch, you will bring it from home too.

When you need to go to the bathroom, your teacher will clean the toilet flusher before and after you go.



When you are done, you will wash your hands before you go back to play.



At the end of the day, your teachers will bring you to the sign-in table. Your grown up will be waiting to pick you up.
